After registering for the virtual presentation, you will receive a password via email with your Zoom link, on Wednesday, July 20, 2022. If you do not receive the Zoom link by 1:00 PM EDT on Thursday, July 21, 2022, send another email to virtualminicon@borhs.org The Society's Zoom subscription allows for only 90 participants. Make your registration early in order to increase your probability that you will be able to attend.

Information for members attending the Eastern Mini-Con by Zoom

If you intend to use Zoom, then you need to have the Zoom software installed on your computer. Go to <https://zoom.us/download>. Click on the appropriate link under “Zoom Client for Meetings” to initiate your installation process. On the day of the meeting, click on the link in the email you received, and you will be in the virtual waiting room for participants. The waiting room will open at 8:30 AM EDT. Early entry to the meeting is recommended because of the time needed to verify registration. After the registration is verified, will be admitted into the meeting. You can leave from and return to the meeting during the day.

Information for members attending the Eastern Mini-Con in Eldersburg

There are no hotels located near the Historical Society building in Eldersburg, Maryland. If you are coming from the south on I-81 and/or the west on I-70, Frederick, MD is probably the best location to look for a motel. Frederick is a 40 minute drive to Eldersburg. If you are coming from the east, north, or south on I-95 or US 29, Columbia, MD is the closest location and a 26 minute drive. An easy method to find a hotel is to enter “lodging near Eldersburg Maryland” in a web mapping program. The prices shown will probably not be the amount you are asked to pay, and they do not include tax and any extra fees.

The B&O Railroad Historical Society Company Store will be present, but vendor tables will not be available because of space limitations. Two tables will be available for models, photographs, and memorabilia display. Coffee, donuts, and pastries will be available in the morning for a donation.

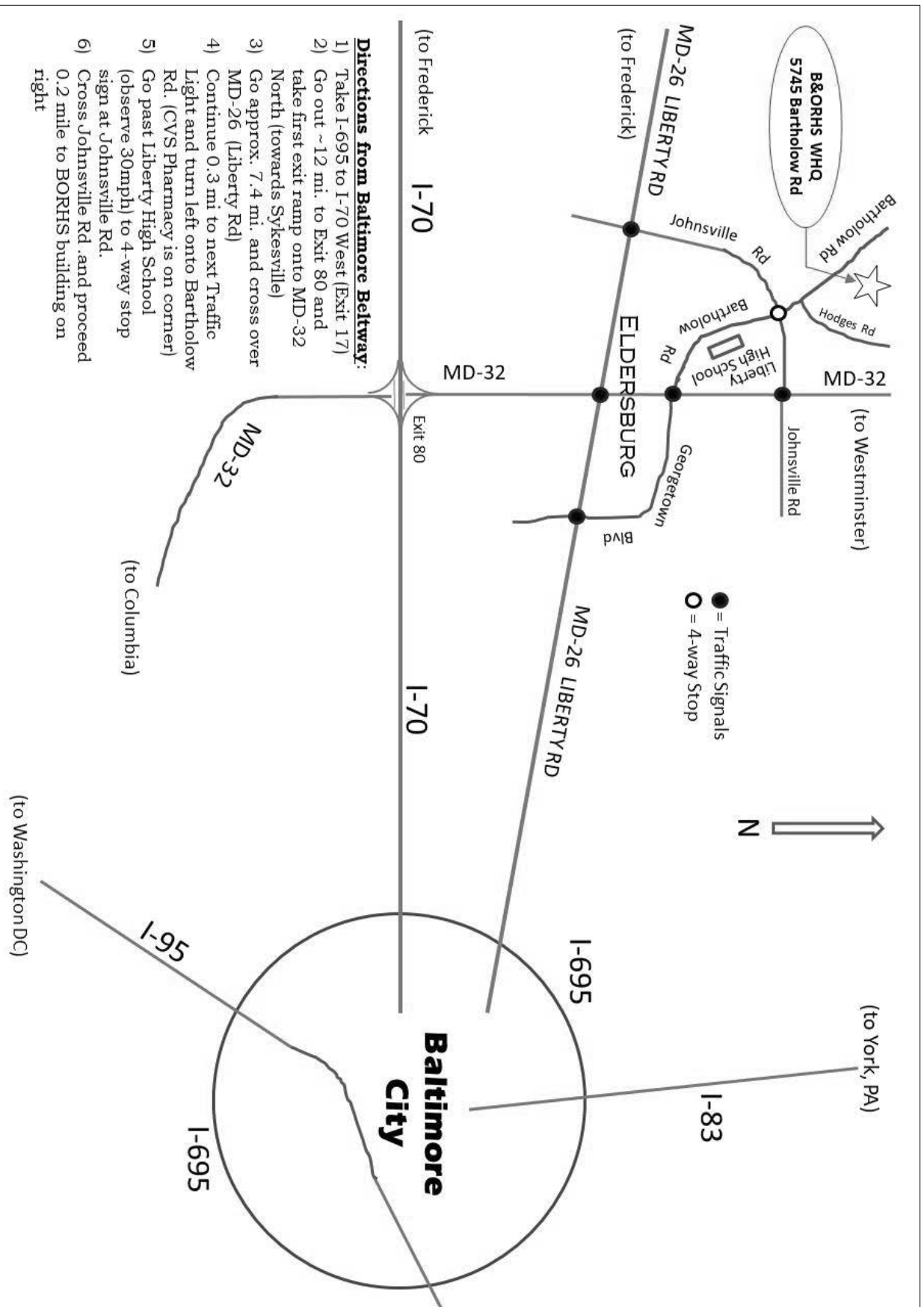

Directions from Baltimore Beltway:

- 1) Take I-695 to I-70 West (Exit 17)
- 2) Go out ~12 mi. to Exit 80 and take first exit ramp onto MD-32 North (towards Sykesville)
- 3) Go approx. 7.4 mi. and cross over MD-26 (Liberty Rd)
- 4) Continue 0.3 mi to next Traffic Light and turn left onto Bartholow Rd. (CVS Pharmacy is on corner)
- 5) Go past Liberty High School (observe 30mph) to 4-way stop sign at Johnsville Rd.
- 6) Cross Johnsville Rd. and proceed 0.2 mile to BORHS building on right
