## B&O Ice Breaker Car Exclusive Run by Bethlehem Car Works

With the introduction of open-air auto racks in the mid-1960's, the B&O needed a means of protecting the automobiles from icicles hanging from the tunnel roofs. The B&O took a dozen 2-bay offset hoppers and installed these racks on top. The ice breaker cars were placed a couple of cars ahead of the auto racks to prevent debris from hitting the precious automobile cargo in those open-air cars. Two of these cars were sold to the Buffalo & Pittsburgh.

These 3-D printed racks come in pairs and, with minimal filing, will easily fit onto 2-bay offset hoppers by Athearn and Atlas.
